District 7 – 8U Coach Pitch Baseball Tournament

District 7 will be hosting its first ever 8U Coach Pitch Baseball Tournament for D7 leagues only. Entry fee will be \$150 per team and must be paid prior to the draw which will be held on June 18th. Checks made payable to Indiana District 7 and mailed to 4007 Owster Ln, 46237 or you can pay with this link <u>https://square.link/u/8kV8TdvP</u> there is a 5 dollar convenience fee. The location of the tournament will be determined later. The tournament will start on Saturday June 21st.

Playing Rules

- Players must be league age 6, 7 or 8 (6-year-olds must have played Coach Pitch during the regular season). Birth certificate will be required at the first game.
- A team can have a minimum of 10 players and no more than 14 players on the roster
- Each team can have up to 4 adult coaches. However, they must have completed the Abuse Training.
- Defense will be 10 players, 6 infielders and 4 outfielders.
- Continuous Batting Order will be used.
- Each batter will get up to 6 pitches per at bat
 - An at bat ends when the batter gets 3 strikes, or puts the ball in play, or doesn't hit or swing at the last pitch.
 - If the batter doesn't swing at or hit the last pitch, he/she will be out.
 - If the batter fouls th<mark>e last pitch, t</mark>he bat will continue.
- When the ball is hit by a batter, the batter runner and base runners can advance until stopped by the defense or an infielder catches the ball and asks for time. Note: The umpire will call time and in the judgment of the umpire, if the runner is more than halfway to the next base, the runner will continue to the next base. If not, runners will return to the last base occupied.
- There will be a time limit of 1 hour and 45 minutes per game. No new inning will start after the time limit has been reached.
- A team can only score 5 runs in an inning. Exception: In the 6th inning, a team can score up to as many runs as possible until each player has batted in the 6th inning. Once the last batter has completed their time at bat in the 6th inning, the half inning is over.
- Run Rule is 15 after 3 innings, 10 after 4 innings or 8 after 5 innings.
- A team can start, play and finish a game with 8 players. However, when the 9th position in the batting order is due up, an out will be assessed.
- No steals.
- Other than the rules above, we will follow regular season rules in the Little League Rulebook.
